Learning activities differ depending upon the levels and size of the classroom as well. Individual attention is void in class with more strength as it is difficult to keep one to one interaction.

Activities to be conducted in Communicative English Teaching:

Group Discussion

GD is one of the important tasks in which students will be interacting among their group and develop social skills, communication, teamwork, and confidence, ultimately leading to improved academic performance and social development.
